Dr. Santoli is the Deputy Director of the Immunization Services Division in the National Immunization Program at the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. This division administers the Vaccines for Children Program and a grants program to state and urban area health departments; conducts health services research; provides training and education to health professionals; and provides for measurement of state and national level vaccination coverage via the National Immunization Survey.

She received her medical degree and trained in pediatrics at the Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine. Following her residency, Dr. Santoli completed a fellowship in General Academic Pediatrics and a Masters in Public Health at the Johns Hopkins Bloomberg School of Public Health.
